GAMER BOYS, SHOVE OVER. There's a new pro player in town, and it might be your mom. Next summer, "casual gaming" site SkillJam.com will offer \$1 million to the best player in video games such as solitaire, Bejeweled 2 (line up colored cubes to win points), and Zuma (zap balls out of a frog's mouth). These are favored by older players, such as soccer moms hiding out in the den. SkillJam President Paul Jensen says 13 players (including some guys) have qualified so far in tournaments costing as little as \$2.50 to enter. The action may not be as intense as the shooter-dominated Cyberathlete Professional League. Still, \$1 million could buy one sweet minivan. *—Ronald Grover*
