## FUN Technologies Inc. Responds to Proposed Offer by Liberty Media Corporation

**TORONTO – June 22, 2007** – FUN Technologies Inc. (“FUN”) (TSX:FUN) (AIM:FUN) today announced it has received a proposal from Liberty Media Corporation (“Liberty”) to offer to purchase any and all outstanding common shares of FUN that are not owned by Liberty at a price per share of GBP 1.635 (approximately C\$3.50) payable in cash. Liberty currently indirectly owns approximately 53% of the outstanding FUN common shares.

FUN’s board of directors will be establishing a committee of independent directors (the “Independent Committee”) to review the proposed offer, to retain an independent valuator and to supervise the preparation of a formal valuation in respect of the FUN common shares.

In addition to other customary terms and conditions, Liberty has indicated that its proposed offer will be subject to the condition that at least a majority of the FUN common shares outstanding or deemed to be outstanding for this purpose that are not owned by Liberty and its affiliates have been validly tendered and not withdrawn.

In due course, after receiving the recommendations of the Independent Committee and the advice of its advisors, the board of directors will make a recommendation to shareholders in connection with the offer as described in Liberty’s take-over bid circular to be sent to FUN’s shareholders.

FUN Technologies Inc. is one of the world's leading online and interactive casual and fantasy sports games and sports information. FUN is 53% owned by Liberty Media Corporation (NASDAQ: LINTA, LCAPA), and FUN’s common shares are listed on both the Toronto Stock Exchange and the Alternative Investment Market (AIM) of the London Stock Exchange under the symbol “FUN”.
